

OSCOLA_2.ens file with error in the journal output type

There has been a version of OSCOLA_2.ens on the Oxford Law Faculty website which inserts 'if vols consecutively' into the year in journal citations, as shown below:

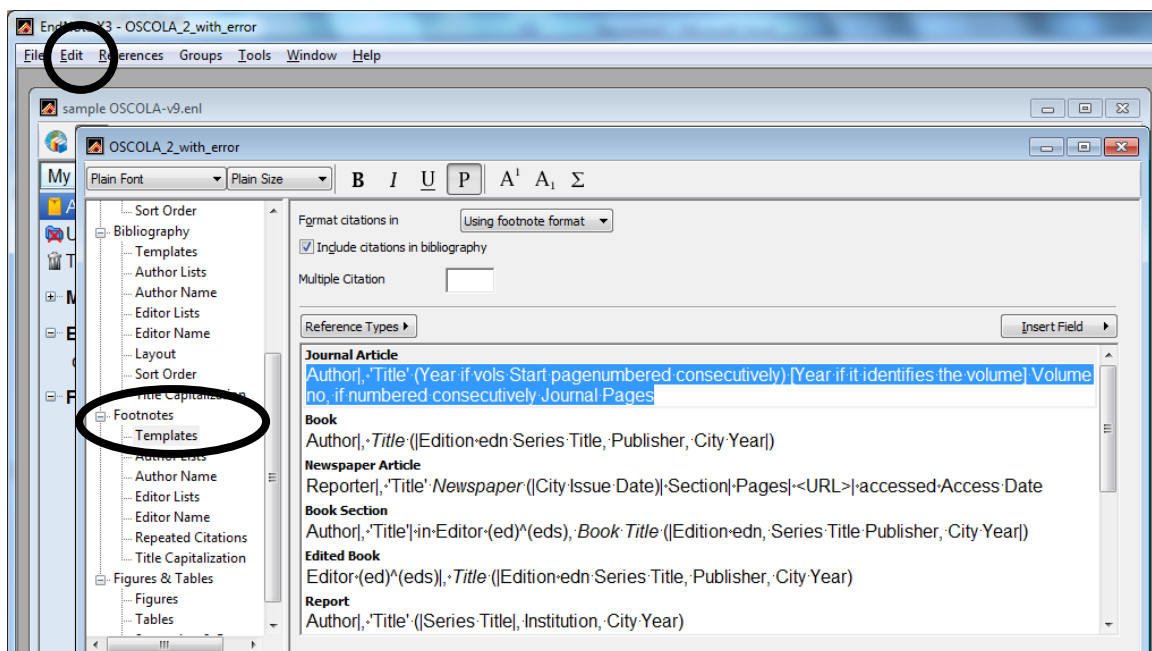

To fix it, in Endnote

1. Go to Edit, choose Edit Output Styles, then choose "Edit OSCOLA 2".
2. In the edit output styles box, go down the left menu until you reach Footnotes, and immediately below that click on Templates.
3. In the Journal Article template, delete **Start page**. The template should then look like this:

Author|, 'Title' (Year if vols numbered consecutively) [Year if it identifies the volume] Volume no, if numbered consecutively Journal Pages

4. Close the output styles box using the little red X on the top right, and Save the change. Do not let Endnote rename the file as OSCOLA_2 Copy. Make sure it is saved simply as OSCOLA_2.ens.
5. Reformat your document to correct any errors showing in the journal references.
