## **CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

**Official Clarifications of the 2024 International Rounds  
and the 2023/2024 Regional Rounds in South Asia, Asia

## ***OneAI and RMSM***

1. Does OneAI have other AI tools similar to RMSM and can earn money from it? **No answer required.**
2. Is the option of labeling posts as “suggested” there by default or does the user have to select it manually (paragraph 10)? **No answer required.**
3. Does RMSM have access only to a person’s posts, in order to accurately emulate their style, or to other data as well, in order to create content with a wider reach? **RMSM learns from the user’s habits, including the user’s engagement (i.e., clicking links), reposts, comments and likes with respect to the posts of other users.**
4. What are the sources through which RMSM learns the users’ habits? Does it learn from sources apart from the user’s posts like the accounts they follow or their web browsing history? **See answer to question no. 3.**
5. The beta version of the RMSM had an interface as a search engine, however the market version was a plugin which often used along with the search engine. Clarify on what the interface of the RMSM works as it might have different impacts on the privacy of the user while using the tool. Will the particular ai track comments as well to learn behaviour? What is the scope of the tool while tracking the behavior of the user? **See answer to question no. 3.**
6. Does RMSM also include engagements by other users (such as likes, comments, or reposts) elicited by the respective posts of an RMSM user for its analysis of the user’s social media behaviour? **No.**
7. Does RMSM interpret emojis as words while learning users’ behaviour, and how did it interpret the emojis used by Una in her posts? **RMSM understands the meaning attributable to specific emojis.**
8. How is RMSM trained regarding the determination of illegal content, as well as the method of assessment to determine that the RMSM is fully compliant with the community standards of each social platform? **No answer required.**
9. Does OneAI have a relevant content moderation mechanism, such as an automated filtering system or human reviewers? **The RMSM’s mechanism of ensuring compliance with relevant community standards is entirely AI based.**
10. Does OneAI employ operators that conduct human review on the functions or content that is generated by RMSM? **See answer to question no. 9.**

11. Is RMSM programmed to be restricted from the use of certain words or phrases while it generates content for its users? **No answer required.**
12. When a user starts their RMSM service in the beta version, the tool collects data from the user for a term of three months. Is this data collection repeated once a user signs up for the market version? **RMSM continuously learns from a user's behaviour.**
13. Does the interpretation or addition of new content come under the scope and extent of "new similar content" suggested or autogenerated by RMSM? **No answer required.**
14. Is the goal of RMSM merely to imitate a user's social media behaviour, or does it include expanding a user's reach on the respective platform? **No answer required.**
15. Are there any past complaints against content generated by RMSM? **No answer required.**

#### ***Digital Safety Act (DSA) and the Digital Regulatory Commission***

16. Does the Digital Safety Act regulate any matters with regards to Artificial Intelligence or auto-generated content on social media platforms? **No answer required.**
17. Is Una the first person to be penalized since the DSA was enacted? **No answer required.**
18. Is the Digital Regulatory Commission financed by the Government of Cero or does the State of Cero influence the selection members of the Commission? **No answer required.**
19. Based on the definition of terrorism in the DSA (outside and in Cero), does it mean that an organization that is recognized as terrorist outside the country falls under this definition? **No answer required.**
20. With reference to paragraphs 5 and 36 of the case, is there any definition or case law on the notion of a "reasonable person" in Cero law and if so, what does it provide? **No answer required.**
21. What is the definition of "Terrorist organisation" given under the Counter-Terrorism Act of Cero and does the definition of "Terrorism" provided in the Digital Safety Act comply with the definition of terrorism provided in the Counter-Terrorism Act? **The definition for 'terrorism' provided in the Digital**

Safety Act corresponds to how a 'terrorist organisation' is defined in the Counter-Terrorism Act.

22. What is the credible complaints criteria that the Digital Regulatory Commission implements? **No answer required.**

### ***Una's Posts and Aftermath***

23. Was Una adequately informed on how RMSM generates content (terms of service)? **No answer required.**
24. Was the content autogenerated on Facebook at 11:00AM on 17th March 2023 influenced solely by Ms. Una's post on Facebook from 16th March 2023 or was it also impacted by the content she posted on Instagram at 9:00AM on 17th March 2023? **No answer required.**
25. Are the 'relevant community standards' of social media platforms mentioned under paragraph 11 of the factsheet, *pari materia* to the actual Facebook/Instagram present community standards? **Yes.**
26. Did Facebook take any measure with posts including the hashtag '#🇪🇸ELA' such as removing those posts? **No answer required.**
27. Is the hashtag '#🇪🇸ELA' being kept by Facebook because Facebook doesn't think this hashtag violates the community standard? In addition to Una, are there any other social media users, including very influential internet celebrities, who have recently been banned for posting content that glorifies ELA as an organization and its actions in Enos ? **No answer required.**
28. How many posts have been published by Una or RMSM related to the brutal armed conflicts in Enos before 14 March 2023? **No answer required.**
29. How many users in Cero used hashtags '#🇪🇸Ela' and '#StopArmingEnos' prior to Una using them in her posts starting from 14 March 2023? **No answer required.**
30. How many unique users have viewed Una's post generated by RMSM on Facebook on 17th March between 11.00 AM and 12.15 PM? **No answer required.**
31. Was the complaint received by the Digital Regulatory Commission a credible complaint? **No answer required.**
32. Were there any complaints to the Digital Regulatory Commission regarding any other of Una's publications before 17 March 2023, and if yes, what was the topic for such complaints and their outcome? **No.**

33. Is the weapons manufacturing facility, where the bomb was detonated, a state facility or a private one (paragraph 29)? *It was a state facility.*
34. What is the typical workforce size at the attacked Cerovian weapons manufacturing facility, and are there notable variations in the number of workers between day and evening shifts? *No answer required.*
35. Does Una have any other sources of income? *No answer required.*

### ***Situation in Enos***

36. To call for a stop of weapon supply for Enos or a ceasefire in Enos, did activities such as protests or demonstrations ever happen since the armed conflict in Enos started, either online or offline? If so, did these activities upgrade into events involving violence, and did the Cerovian government take any measures towards these activities? *No answer required.*
37. Have there been any other instances of violence or acts of terrorism reported in Cero or Enos, either recently or in the past? And was the terrorist bombing in Cero taken into account as one of the factors in penalizing Una? *No answer required.*
38. Has there been any indication that ELA committed any acts of terrorism? *No answer required.*

### ***Court Proceedings***

39. Was there any prior judicial practice of Cerovian courts applying the Digital Safety Act to AI when resolving disputes? *No answer required.*
40. Is there any domestic case-law in the state of Cero based on the infringement of the Digital Safety Act regarding other persons expressing their opinion upon the conflict between ELA and the Enosian Military, in favour of either side of the opposing parties, and, if so, what did the Cerovian Courts decide? *No answer required.*
41. How many users were prosecuted under the Digital Safety Act for posts which contained the hashtags “#☹️Ela” and “#StopArmingEnos”? *No answer required.*
42. Were any other users of social media prosecuted as a result of expressing solidarity with ELA? *No answer required.*

43. Did the government of Cero impose publicly a state of emergency in Cero when the two Applicants were prosecuted and convicted? **No.**
44. On what basis did the court of Cero reach its conclusion that the post of 17 March was jointly produced by RMSM and Una? **No answer required.**
45. In light of the (Universal Court of Human Rights) court's decision to hear the applications together, is it possible for each party to claim the other party's liability? **No answer required.**
46. Since the UCHR has decided to hear the applications together under two issues, do the parties retain their initial hostile stances against each other or do they act in tandem with each other? **No answer required.**

***Other***

47. Are the responsibilities owed by the people as per Article 19 of the Constitution enforceable in the court or by the government? Are they compulsory? **No answer required.**
