# **PRICE MEDIA LAW MOOT COURT 2025/2026**

## **CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

**Official Clarifications of the 2026 International Rounds  
and the 2025/2026 Regional Rounds in South Asia, Asia  
Pacific, Europe, the Americas, the Middle East, and Africa**

**Note: We have received in more than 70 questions from all teams. The Author of the Competition Case provided the Clarifications below. All other questions were determined to not require an answer and the Competition Case as originally drafted provides all necessary information.**

**Note 2: Document updated on 11/12/2025 with changes to question 6.**

- 1) Is the Uxi Intelligence Agency (UIA) classified under Uxian law as an executive body, and is the Intelligence and National Security Tribunal (INST) a judicial body? **The INST is an independent judicial body.**
- 2) Do the FPA and UNSA have additional provisions for safeguards and/or sanctions? **Additional legal provisions are not pertinent for the present case.**
- 3) Whether the process for obtaining a residency permit in Uxi includes the collection of biometric data, such as photographs and fingerprints? **Yes, biometric data is collected for all types of visa and residency permits in Uxi.**
- 4) Paragraph 23 states that Broken Code's exposé was removed worldwide on 10 December 2025. Was the removal carried out by Broken Code/Graviola, or by Uxian authorities pursuant to the injunction? **Broken Code's team removed the exposé at Graviola's direction.**
- 5) How many followers did Dr. Vitoria have on her social media platforms? **Approximately half a million on Tagram and a million on FUXIco.**
- 6) Paragraph 22 states that the exposé was scheduled for publication on 1 December 2024, whereas paragraph 23 refers to events on 1 December 2025. Is there a clarification of which date is correct? **Correction: Graviola and Dr Vitoria made similar posts on December 1, 2025 [para. 23] (Updated to correct the date)**
