Primary Sources

Cases

Give the parties' names, followed by the medium neutral citation, followed by the *Law Reports* citation. If there is no medium neutral citation, give the *Law Reports* citation followed by the court identifier in brackets. If the case is not reported in the *Law Reports*, cite the *Weekly Law Reports* or *All England Law Reports* instead, or failing that a specialist report.

When pinpointing, give paragraph numbers in square brackets at the end of the citation. If the judgment has no paragraph numbers, provide the page number pinpoint after the court identifier.
