Applications are invited for a stipendiary *or* a non-stipendiary Junior Research Fellowship, tenable for three years from 1st October 2017, in Constitutional Law and/or Constitutional Theory. The successful candidate is likely to be at or near the postdoctoral level. This post is sponsored by the Programme for the Foundations of Law and Constitutional Government at the University of Oxford. The Junior Research Fellow must engage in original research, and may undertake a limited amount of teaching with the consent of the College. The combined salary and housing allowance (payable if the appointee does not take up College accommodation) are £31,558 p.a.
