

Policy on Associates

There are two categories of Associate at the Centre for Socio-Legal Studies.

1. CSLS Associate is open to four categories of scholars:

a. **Senior Associates:** Prominent scholars who have had a longstanding relationship with the Centre, or whose association with the Centre enhances its reputation. This status will be offered by invitation, and not by application.

b. **University Associates:** Scholars holding an established post within the University of Oxford, who are engaged in research in an area of relevance to the CSLS. This status is granted via either application or invitation.

c. **CSLS Post-docs:** CSLS Fixed Term Fellows whose contract has ended before they have secured a new job or CSLS students who have been awarded their DPhil. This status is granted via application, and will be awarded for up to two years or until an appointment to a job is secured. The candidate should approach the Director with a written letter, which will be reported to the General Purposes Committee for final approval.

2. Programme Associate:

This status is open to researchers who are actively working with one of the CSLS Programmes on a specific project. This status is limited to the period while a specific task is carried out. The status is granted by the GPC on the basis of a written justification by the Head of the candidate's Programme, giving a clear explanation of the task that the candidate is expected to carry out, the candidate's qualifications to perform that task, the expected outcome, and the duration of the work.
